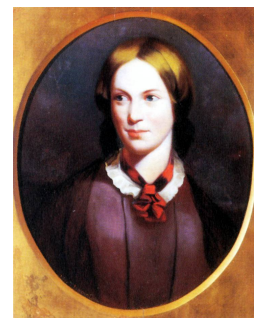


## Activity 2 – Fill in the blanks – GCSE English on Jane Eyre
