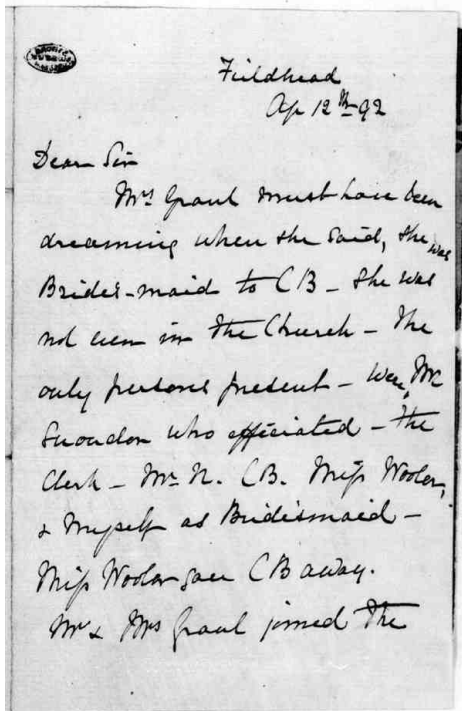


## Ellen Nussey – Source 2

Ellen Nussey wrote to J A Erskine Stuart an author who had published a book called *Bronte Country: Its Topography, Antiquities and History*. Stuart's book was originally published in 1888.



### **Transcription: 12<sup>th</sup> April 1892 –Ellen Nussey to J.A. Erskine Stuart:**

Dear Sir

Mrs Grant must have been dreaming when she said, she was Brides-maid to CB – She was not even in the Church – the only persons present were Mr Snowdon, who officiated, the Clerk, Mr. N, Miss Wooler and myself as Bridesmaid. Miss Wooler gave CB away. Mr and Mrs Grant joined the small party at breakfast, after which all dispersed. Bride and Bridegroom on their travels. Pray set this right.
